A Tribute to Diana Hockaday by John Turner

Diana has retired from local politics for health reasons. She suffered a stroke in November last year and is now recovering in Oakwood Nursing Home, Colney.

I first came across her as a colleague of my wife Joan at the John Innes Research Centre in Norwich. The meticulous attention to detail required of a research microbiologist was also evident in her Council work. It showed in her tireless approach to what is simplistically called "casework". That's listening to what a resident's problem is, researching it, looking up Council papers (maybe searching the planning system...), coming back with an answer, in short, hours of voluntary work. Diana's efforts in this field saw her elected at District and County level, and the fact that she has been Chair of Norfolk County Council says better than I can here how good her work was.

When Diana and I were elected to the Town Council in the same by-election, I was grateful for her help showing me as a new Councillor how it all works (so that's patience to add to her list of virtues).

Despite her public profile, Diana is a very private person. Yes, she threw herself even more wholeheartedly into Council work when her husband Tony died, but she has always needed time for herself and family: a session of painting or tennis being the therapy of choice....we all wish Diana a speedy recovery.
