2005 Marks the bicentenary of the death of one of Norfolk's most famous sons—Horatio Nelson.

He was mortally wounded at the Battle of Trafalgar 1805 whilst the combined fleets of Spain and France were defeated.

Next year will see a number of events to mark the occasion, one of which will be a performance by Wymondham Choral Society in Wymondham Abbey of Hayden's Nelson Mass. This will be one of three concerts planned for the year by the Choral Society.
